SLAVES TO FASHION continues to honor 50 years of heavy metal.

The band's third single, "Sex, Drugs & Rock 'N' Roll ", is a tribute to the dangerous and glamorous glam metal of the 1980's. Also called hair metal, the genre is a mix of traditional heavy metal and commercial pop music. The song was mixed by Beau Hill, who produced hits and albums for bands like Ratt, Warrant, Winger, Europe and Twisted Sister in the glorious days of the genre.
